- Copy of the Vermont Regulations for Lead Control V.S.A. Title 18, Chapter 38
- Copy of the written respiratory program that includes the following:
 - Procedures for respirator use
 - Employee fit test records
 - Physicians approval for each employee to wear respirator
 - Proper respirator choice and filter usage
- Air Sampling protocol and results
- Copy of the written lead compliance program on site
- Copy of the Contractor Entity license
- Copy of the Supervisor License
- Copy of all worker's Licenses
- Vt. Dept. of Health Lead permit posted
- Project waivers posted
- Air Monitoring Sample Database on site
- Job Specifications on site
- Sign in /Sign out log
- Emergency action plan posted
- Prevailing wages posted (if Davis-Bacon act applies)
- List of all subcontractors to enter work area after clearance with Vt. Dept. Health Waivers
- Protective clothing available (tyvek suits, rubber gloves, disposable foot covers)
- Hard Hats and Safety Glasses available when required
- Lead Warning Signs posted
- Job area secured
- HVAC shut down and secured or properly filtered
- GFI outlets on all tools and electrical devices
- Movable objects removed from work area
- Non-Movable objects covered with 6-Mil Poly
- Work area isolated by Dust flaps on door ways
- Window poly installed
- Floor poly installed
- Decontamination/washing area installed contiguous to work area. 3 stage decon with shower installed where feasible. Waste water filtered.
- Decontamination plan / Entrance and Exit procedures posted.
- Negative air utilized when necessary vented to outside
- Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) for all chemicals used on site
- Name of testing, clearance, and monitoring consultants posted
- Proof of insurance on site
- Charged Fire Extinguisher available
