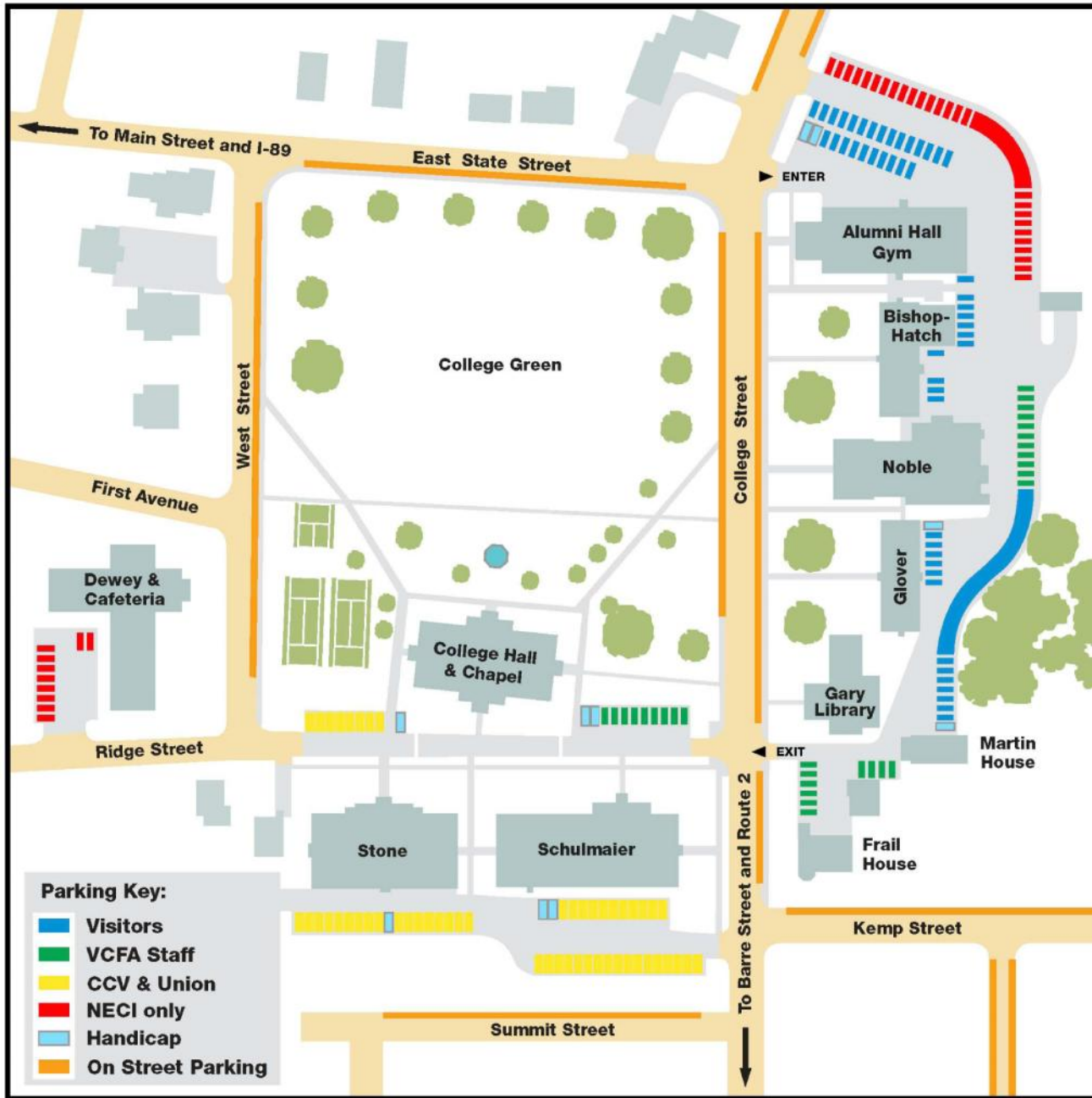

Thank you for visiting Vermont College of Fine Arts. This free parking permit is made available to all guests. You are welcome to park on the street if you find a spot available; no pass is required. If parking on the street, you must comply with city parking regulations: only park in LEGAL street parking spots (no “permit parking only) spots or “no parking” zones. The city will ticket. If there are no spots on the street, we recommend that you display this pass and park in the marked BLUE parking lots. Please DO NOT parking in Blue parking spots that say “NECI Staff Parking Only” (see map) or “Facilities Parking Only.”

Directions

From Exit 8 off I-89 (N or S)
 Off I-89, follow the access road and make a left at the 4th light (Main Street/Route 12 North). In the middle of town, there is a stop light in the middle of an intersection. Make a right onto East State Street. The VCFA campus is at the top of the hill on the right. A free parking permit is required to park in campus parking lots; see "Parking" for more information.

Parking

Guests are welcome to park on city streets if a spot is available; no pass is required. Please note that there is no overnight parking on Montpelier city streets from November 15-April 1.

A free visitor's parking permit is required for those wishing to park in campus parking lots. This permit can be acquired from your campus host. Please display this parking pass on your dashboard during your stay.
