Mutual of Omaha is the risk bearing entity for the NASCC health insurance plan. They underwrite the program, developing rates based on claims experience, current market trends, adequate reserves, administrative costs and margins. Prior to the policy's anniversary date (July 1) each year, the rates are negotiated by Mutual and Willis to determine the cost per member for the following year. Mutual of Omaha will also administer all of the AD&D claims.
